

Create a Project

By creating a project, you can browse across files.

1. Create a project

Click File -> New Project

Location: The folder where you wish to create the project file

Project Name: Name of the project file you wish to create. The project file will have the extension .spr, .ppr or sur

2. Add source files and header files to the project

Click <Add Files> in Project Management Menu.

Select the radio button "All Source Files" and Click <Add>

Or Select files from the displayed list and click <Add>

"Files of Type" determines the displayed list

3. Set the Include-Path-Sequence

Click <Include Path> in the Project Management Menu.

In the "Include Path" menu, the folder at the top is searched first.

- To add a new entry in the sequence:

Click <Add New>.

Fill a folder name in the new entry. (Use <Browse> or the keyboard.)

- To delete, move-up, or move-down:

Click the entry, then click <Remove>, <Move Up>, or <Move Down>.

- To modify an existing entry:

Click the entry, then edit using the keyboard or the <Browse> button.

- Select the "Include subfolders" box if header files are #included from the sub-folders too.

4. Parse All Files

Click <Parse All> in the Project Management Menu.

<p>5. After parsing, check for Missing header files.</p>	<p>Click" Generate Missing Include Files Report " icon (rightmost) in the Project Management Menu</p>
<p>If header files are missing, some type names may remain undefined and result in syntax errors. Syntax errors are displayed in pink color. If a syntax error involves a function-header (start of a function), then the function is not recognized and hence its flowchart is not available.</p>	
<p>If any header files are missing,</p>	<p>Add the necessary folders to the Include-Path-Sequence so that Crystal Flow can find the header files</p>
<p>After you change or add folders to the Include-Path-Sequence,</p>	<p>Reparse All Files.</p>
