Undocking/Docking Windows

Ordinarily, the Browse window is in a docked state;

Flowchart and Tree windows are in a floating state.

- To undock a docked window, click on the “double line” bar on the frame of the window.
- When you drag the flowchart or tree window, it docks whenever it hits a docking boundary (on the left, right, top or bottom).

If you do not wish to dock it, just keep dragging it further.

Or if you press the Ctrl key while dragging, it will not dock at all

- The tabs <Code Only>, <Flow Only>, <Code+Flow> are effective only when the flowchart and tree windows are floating windows (i.e. not docked)

If you close the Browse window

To open the Browse Window again, click on the <Project Browse Panel> icon in the toolbar at the top.

Or use the pull-down menu View->Browse Window.

<Code Only>, <Flow Only>, <Code + Flow> etc.

Viewing code and flowchart side by side

When the flowchart window or the tree window are present as floating windows, clicking <Code Only> tab at the bottom of the window minimizes them so that you can get an unobstructed view of the code.

If the flowchart window or the tree window is docked, then <Code Only> has no effect.

Clicking <Flow Only> maximizes the flowchart window.

Click <Code + Flow> to get a side-by-side view of the browser, code & flowchart windows.

You can achieve the above effects using the Maximize, Restore icons of a window and resizing the window. However, <Code Only>, <Flow Only> etc. provide convenient short-cuts.

Quick buttons

(two columns of buttons - to the right)

Click <TALL> to view Quick buttons

Click <Full Screen> to hide Quick buttons

Some handy operations at the click of a button:

- <ScrlTop>, <ScrlMid>, <ScrlBott>
Scroll current line to Top, Middle, Bottom
- <Fun↓>, <Fun↑>
Go to Next Function / Previous Function
- <Outer>
Go to Outer indent level
- <Skip↓>, <Skip↑>
Go to Next statement at the current indent level

Help

Right-click on <Code Only> to view its help info.

Right-click on any Quick Button (in the two columns at the right edge of the window).

Right-click on a command in the pull-down menus
